Greetings from the Board of Directors

The annual meeting is rapidly approaching and the community will be voting on three members positions this year and approving the proposed budget for 2009. We encourage you to take interest in guiding your community and consider volunteering your time toward improving our neighborhood. Nomination forms will be mailed out with the yearly meeting notifications. We need residents to serve on both the board and committees that make recommendations to the board.

Tropical storm Fay refreshed our memory as to how a storm can affect our everyday life. With almost two months to go in the current hurricane season, everyone should take steps to ensure your family's safety and well being. Make

sure your home owners insurance is up to date, have a family evacuation plan and sufficient supplies on hand.

Based upon a recommendation from the Rules and Safety Committee the Board has amended the rule on motorcycles. We now will allow immediate family members (21 and over) living at home to apply for a permit to operate a motorcycle in the subdivision. These members will be required to follow all the established rules and regulations.

Delinquencies continue to increase and your board has been forced to take action quickly to ensure we remain on a solid financial base. We continue to work with our residents that are experiencing problems.

Work is progressing on the Sandal Wood Canal, but a completion date is still unknown. We still may face periodic bridge closures.

Garden Clippings

August was a little more soggy thanks to Fay, who overstayed her welcome! We lost track of actual rainfall here in The Woods but a cautious guesstimate puts Fay's rainfall at approx. 7 inches. It sure brought our pond levels back to normal but caused a lot of havoc with plants that are drought-tolerant. The best way to save those plants that got too much rain is to simply let them dry out and clip off the dead ends. In all likelihood, the plants will come back. Be sure to pick up all the dead leaves which may be clumped in your yard – these clumps can kill the grass under them very quickly. Buddy & Tommy have done a great job of clearing off the bike and nature trails

form all the debris that fell during Fay. Several trees around the community clubhouse still need to be taken down and we have a crew hard at work on that as well.

WHAT TO PLANT NOW THAT SEPTEMBER IS HERE?

Garden mums are always a good addition to your yard or planters. And if you clip off the dead ends (dead head the plants), you can get at least two blooms from the mums yet this year. Got a

spot that simply won't allow anything to grow??? Try ornamental peanut grass. There are several varieties available at local nurseries – be sure to pick the right now for your space (shady, part sun, or full sun). The city of Jacksonville uses peanut grass for all its new medians strips because, once established, it needs little rain and only needs to be mowed once a year. The Jacksonville Zoo also uses peanut grass for all its ground cover areas. It will produce glorious grass ground cover year round.

PS. We did not see any at Lowe's or Home Depot but Plant Ranch & Earth Works have plenty for sale.

Finance Committee Update

2009 BUDGET:

We are pleased to inform you that the 2009 proposed budget contains no increase in the quarterly assessments. In order for this budget to be viable, our community will need to continue to operate under budget in 2008 and end the year with a surplus of operating and reserve funds.

OPERATING AND RESERVE FUNDS:

Our community stayed within the operating budget for the period January

through July 2008 with a surplus of \$49,167. The Reserve Fund July 31, 2008 balance of \$623,492 is 101 percent of the recommended balance for 2008.

Here is a summary of our community's finances through July 2008. We look forward to providing you future updates.
