OK, OK, OK.... enough whining out there! It is far too early to begin trimming dead limbs or shrubs. I know it's painful to see but virtually everyone now has dead "stuff" in their yards. We're all in the same boat right now! Leave things alone (except for weeds) until after March 15th. The Ideas of March is important for more reasons than just the death of Caesar! We are still in danger of more frost days and anything you trim up now will only get worse with the next frost.

So, what can you do now? You CAN plant petunias, pansies and snapdragons. All will last nicely into April. You CAN plant broccoli and ornamental cabbage for a wonderful look and feel that will last until April as well.

Hit the local nurseries for ideas on spring planting – dream a little – change things up – add some excitement to your back or front yard.

Another experience that you might have now is mole activity in your yard. There are two things you do about this – leave it alone (moles are eating the grubs that eat your grass roots so that's a good thing) or you can set traps for the little pests. Beware though; those traps can also harm your pets. And then you always need to worry about the disposal of the dead moles. Best advice – let nature take its course. The moles will leave once their food supply is gone.
