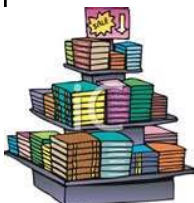

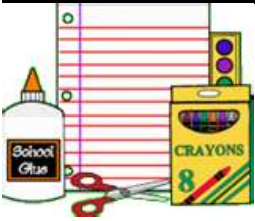

Variance Request forms are available in The Woods office, and are reviewed by the ARC regularly. Plan ahead & please keep in mind that complex plans, requests requiring additional information or clarification, & other circumstances may delay approval time. Be sure to include a survey or drawing to show the proposed location, as well as any pamphlets, brochures, or samples of materials to be used to help facilitate your request more efficiently.
