A \$5.00 registration fee will get your home included on a neighborhood map with descriptions of your items for sale, a real bargain given all the benefits you receive in return. W.O.W. provides newspaper ads, posts signs around the boundaries of our neighborhood, supplies each registered household with an official Participant Packet, distributes yard sale lists to visitors the day of the event, and arranges for the pick-up of any gently used goods (No trash, please) after the sale by the Salvation Army. Use this opportunity to get rid of a lot of cool stuff you no longer need, but could bless someone else in his or her household. Amazing publicity and the incredible turnout of previous years always makes for hundreds of eager customers. You keep all the money you make. Your registration fee pays for the advertising, printing, and other costs associated with the event.



A word of caution: the start time is somewhat flexible. If the line becomes long and begins to cause traffic problems, customers may be admitted as early as 7 a.m. Woods residents have been known to begin their shopping even earlier.

Also, if you decide to close up shop early or just have a few things around the house with which you want to bless someone else, the Salvation Army will have a truck located at the Woods Clubhouse to accept these items throughout the day of the sale. 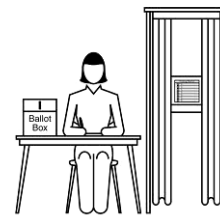
