Notice from the Board

THE CHANGE IN BOAT PARKING RULES!!! The Woods Community will adhere to the City Municipal Code regarding the parking, storage and/or use of boats. Please read the basic code below and check out the link for additional information.

Sec. 656.409. Parking, storage or use of recreational vehicles and boats...
"Boats, boat trailers, horse trailers or any other trailer and recreational vehicles may be parked or stored in a required rear or side yard but not in required front yards, provided however, that these vehicles may be parked anywhere on residential premises **not to exceed 24 hours** during loading & unloading." (Ord. 91-59-148, § 1)

A Message From Rules & Safety



Safeguard your loved ones and yourself! Pedestrians, bicycles, children, and pets can be difficult for motorists to see... please remember to wear **VISIBLE** safety reflectors when out and about at night or during the early morning hours. Bicycles should ride **WITH** the flow of traffic. Runners/walkers should go **AGAINST** the traffic when not using the sidewalk.

DRIVERS: SLOW DOWN! The posted speed limit is **25 mph**. Buckle up! Come to a complete stop at all stop signs. JSO has been on-site and will issue tickets to violators.

☺ **TRASH REMINDER:** Trash cans must be stored in a non-visible location. Trash & recycle pick-up is Wednesday. Lawn clippings & bulk items are picked up on Thursdays. Bulk items must be pre-arranged by calling 630-CITY (2489). City guidelines state that trash receptacles / recycle bins / and lawn debris should not be placed curbside earlier than 5 p.m. on the day before collection day & empty cans removed from the curb no later than 6 a.m. the day after scheduled collections. ☺ **PARKING REMINDER:** Please remember, parking on lawns is strictly prohibited.

☺ **MEMORIAL DAY REMINDER:** The Pool will be open Memorial Day but closed Tuesday, May 29th. The Woods Office will be closed Monday, May 28th.
